Magirus signs Yoggie Security Systems™

BRACKNELL, UK– Magirus, one of the leading European IT systems and software distributors, announced today the signing of a new security vendor – Yoggie Security Systems™ - to its UK portfolio. This is an integral part of Magirus' strategy to provide partners with a best-of-breed portfolio of established and emerging security software applications, hardware and services.

Magirus will begin distribution immediately of the entire portfolio of multi-functional security appliances from Yoggie Security Systems™.

Magirus' appointment of the new vendor provides a broader security portfolio, creating opportunities for existing as well as new partners. The new additions to the portfolio include:

The **Yoggie Pico Pro™** - this appliance offloads 13 security applications* onto a miniature, Linux-based computer contained in a USB stick which fits into a PC or laptop's USB port.

The **Yoggie Gatekeeper Pro™** which is a pioneering security appliance for laptops and PCs and in February won the RSA Innovation Station 2007 award. The Yoggie Gatekeeper Pro™ appliance can also support multiple computing devices. This occurs via a network cable in conjunction with a standard router, allowing up to five PCs and/or laptops to be secured.

Uniquely, both the Yoggie Pico Pro™ and Yoggie Gatekeeper Pro™ offload all security applications onto the appliances. Both appliances allow Internet traffic to be screened before it executes on the laptop or PC; and only once Internet traffic (including, for example, all email content and any respective attachments) has been cleansed - is it allowed to enter the computer.

The products have been developed for corporate users, whether they are used as stand alone protection for a single computing device or as part of a centrally controlled corporate security

strategy. They allow IT managers to extend control over their remote workforces by enforcing security policy for all PCs and laptops via the Yoggie Management Server™. The server monitors and manages centrally the fleet of Yoggie Pico Pro™ and Yoggie Gatekeeper Pro™ devices.

Magirus is supporting the introduction of these innovative security appliances to the UK channel.

Stephen Williams, managing director at security reseller, Alizian said, “We see Magirus’s best of breed approach to security as a good fit for our business.” He added, “Yoggie is a good case in point. It’s not often you can say that there is genuine innovation, however these all-in-one appliances provide a leap in the level of Wifi security on offer for remote workers.”
