



Firmware 1.3.6 Release Notes

Added

1. IDS/IPS signature updates

IDS/IPS update mechanism now allows immediate signature updates without requiring firmware updates. The signature database now provides enhanced capabilities and dramatically reduces false positives.

2. Custom Email Rules

The Anti-Spam engine can now apply custom email rules defined by the user.

3. Custom Web Filtering Rules

The Web Filtering engine can now apply custom Web Filtering rules defined by the user.

4. VPN Client Event Log

A new log was added for the VPN Client events.

5. Clear Log Option

The Security Log and the System Log can now be cleared.

6. Temperature Control Mechanism

A new Temperature Control Mechanism was added. The new mechanism monitors CPU usage and adjusts the processor's frequency accordingly.

7. More options in Generic VPN Manual Settings

Generic VPN configuration now allows the user to manually choose both the encryption and authentication methods to be used in the IPsec tunnel.

8. Check Point VPN Client

Yoggie Gatekeeper's VPN Client now supports Check Point VPN NGX gateway versions R60 and above.

9. Yoggie Management Server Framework

Yoggie Management Server (YMS) 1.3.0 new features are supported in the Gatekeeper's Firmware.

10. NetASQ VPN Client

Yoggie Gatekeeper's VPN Client now supports NetASQ Firewall Version 7.0.0.1 and above.

Fixed

Issue #081 FTP security log events did not show the URLs in the event description field.

- Issue #176** Large e-mail messages were not always fully inspected by the Yoggie spam engine.
- Issue #335** Configuration fields in the VPN screen were fixed to properly display a blank field when no values were defined.
- Issue #473** The next button in the Security Log display moved to the next page on click even when the log was empty.
- Issue #477** When changing Gatekeeper configuration from Pass-through mode to Redirect mode the Internet connection was temporarily lost.
- Issue #487** Improved Japanese emails support.
- Issue #622** A warning message now prompts the user when trying to access the Management Console with a browser configured to block JavaScript.
- Issue #623** In certain rare occasions the Yoggie Management Console would display mobile code instead of executing it.
- Issue #636** User could enable Web Filtering even if no category was selected.
- Issue #655** Better support for Web sites which force the use of HTTP chunk-encoding in contradiction to the standard HTTP.
- Issue #657** When configuring the Firewall, a wrong error message was displayed when the configured port range was invalid.
- Issue #691**
- Issue #690** There was no event in the Security Log for blocked files of more than 10MB.
- Issue #692** Some entries in the Security Log table displayed `>` instead of `->`.
- Issue #698** When entering a password in the Management Console login only the first 8 letters were read.
- Issue #716** Security Log event description did not have a copy option.
- Issue #718** The Gatekeeper's IP address was not checked before it was changed. This allowed the user to configure an illegal IP.
- Issue #723** Hebrew characters were not supported in the console password.
- Issue #726** User was able to click on the next button even after the records list ended.
- Issue #728** Anti-Spam engine did not properly support scanning of large emails (up to 12M).
